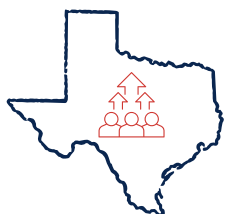


Texas' Favorable Business Climate Continues to Drive Jobs, Investment, and Growth

What It Takes to Build a Growing Texas



Each American uses the equivalent of about **50 to 60 pounds of aggregates per day**



A mile of six-lane highway uses approximately **15,000 yards of concrete**



The average residential home in Texas uses approximately **100 Yards of concrete**



An average Hospital uses approximately **30,000 yards of concrete**

Texas' projected population growth will require tens of millions of additional tons of aggregates and concrete every year—**making a strong, local supply of materials essential to keeping up with demand and keeping costs affordable.**

Local Materials Benefit Communities Across Texas



Transportation can influence up to 70% of material costs — **making local materials essential to keeping housing, roads, and infrastructure affordable** for Texas families and taxpayers



When materials must travel farther, communities face **higher costs, longer delays, increased traffic, and slower delivery of critical infrastructure**



Reliable local supply helps **communities respond to rapid growth** with timely, affordable infrastructure that **supports local jobs, reliable transportation, and quality of life**



Limited aggregates deposit locations make local access **critical to building the roads, homes, schools, and infrastructure** communities rely on



Shorter delivery distances **reduce traffic, road wear, and strain on local infrastructure**



Local concrete supply helps communities keep pace with growth while **reducing delays to the infrastructure families and businesses rely on**

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
